



Field Allocation Process



Cosumnes CSD will host a serpentine draft for the allocation of sports fields. When all organizations have chosen their first session, the orders will reverse, so that the organization that chose last in the first round will choose first in the second round.

Eligible Programs

The Cosumnes CSD will consider the following guidelines when determining a group's eligibility for the field allocation draft:

Recreation Programs

- A non-profit youth sports organization exclusively serving youth 19 years and younger.
- Organization is comprised of at least five teams.
- Organization does not make player cuts – all registrants play.
- Each player must receive a minimum amount of mandated playing time except for reasons of injury, illness or discipline.
- A majority of the organization's players (50%+1) reside in the CSD boundaries (95624, 95757 and 95758).

Competitive Programs

- A non-profit youth sports organization exclusively serving youth 19 years and younger.
- Organization is comprised of at least five teams.
- At least 60% of the organization's players reside in the CSD boundaries (95624, 95757 and 95758).

Cosumnes CSD reserves the right to classify each individual program. Organizations may have multiple programs within each category. Recreation programs may not secure fields on behalf of competitive programs.

Field Allocation Priority

First Priority	District Programs (leagues, camps, clinics)
Second Priority	CSD tournament rentals and EGUSD
Third Priority	Recreation programs
Fourth Priority	Competitive programs
Fifth Priority	Other rentals

Allocation Modifications

Trades are not allowed during the field allocation draft. After the draft, organizations are encouraged to work together throughout the allocation period to help meet each other's needs. Any changes to the allocation must be approved by Cosumnes CSD.

Field User Fee Schedule

Annual User Fee (per player)	\$12
Light Fee (per hour)	\$20
Premium Use Fee	\$1,500 per field per year

Premium Use Fee

The premium use fee is applicable to BSP multi-purpose synthetic turf fields. The total cost is divided among all user groups based upon their percentage of use. For example, if organization A uses 1 BSP field during 50% of the year, then organization A is responsible for 50% of the \$1,500 field fee (\$750).

Platinum & Gold Fields

Platinum and Gold fields are defined as follows:

Platinum & Gold Field Sessions

Weekdays (12 – 15 sessions)

Each Platinum and Gold field will be allocated between the hours of 4 – 8:30pm Monday – Friday, and 8am – 8pm Saturday and Sunday. During the week, these fields will be allocated on a daily basis, with each 4 – 8:30pm time block counting as three sessions towards an organization’s total. Gold fields will have a scheduled rest one weeknight per week.

Example: ABC League chooses Fridays at BSP 1 for their March-May season.

Weekends (12 sessions)

Platinum and Gold fields will be divided into two time blocks on Saturdays and Sundays, 8am – 2pm & 2 – 8pm, with each 6 hour block counting as three sessions towards an organization's total.

Example: ABC League chooses Saturdays at BSP 1 from 2:00pm-8:00pm for their January-March season.

Silver Fields

Silver fields are natural fields without lighting. Silver fields will be allocated to one user group who will have priority use of the field during their season between the hours of 4 – 8:30pm Monday – Friday, and 8am – 8pm Saturday and Sunday.

Example: ABC League is allocated Strong Soccer Field for their July-November Season.

Determining Field Needs

An organization's field needs will be determined based on their total number of teams. For example:

- Organization X is comprised of 71 teams
- Organization X is eligible for 213 sessions for its 71 teams - based on 3 sessions per team each week.
 - $71 \text{ teams} * 3 \text{ weekly sessions per team} = 213 \text{ sessions}$
- Each field has a total number of 24 sessions per week, 12 on weekdays and 12 on weekends.
- Organization X is eligible for 9 fields. This number is determined by dividing an organization's total number of sessions (213) by the number of weekly sessions per field (24).
 - $213 \text{ sessions} / 24 \text{ weekly sessions per field} = 9 \text{ fields}$

Fields allocated to a user group by other local agencies will be considered when determining an organization's field needs.
