



Field Allocation Audit Policy

Cosumnes CSD (District) reserves the right to conduct random audits to establish the residency status of participants. To facilitate this process, each organization must submit team rosters for every season and/or program for which they are allocated fields. A supporting document, such as a: utility bill, cable/internet bill or waste management bill is required to verify current residency status of each participant. If an organization does not provide the documentation necessary to verify a participant's residency status, that participant will be considered a non-resident.

District staff reserves the right to conduct random site audits to ensure that fields are being utilized by the appropriate users. During an audit each coach is required to provide their name to district staff, along with a photo ID. Coaches must also state the name of each participant on their roster. Organizations that are uncooperative during audits may forfeit their current field allocation, and may become ineligible for future field allocations.

District reserves the right to audit any piece of information represented on an organization's field allocation application. Misinformation may result in corrective action up to and including prohibiting future field usage.
