Command was established and the incident was balanced to a level 2 Haz-Mat call. Sacramento City Fire Department Haz-Mat 7, and Sacramento County Hazardous Materials representative responded. Elk Grove Police were requested to take Scene Management. Investigation found that the vehicle had been reported stolen the night before. Engine 73 crew was able to stop the leak of additional fuel.

Elk Grove Police arrived to take control of the vehicle with CSO Debbie Brock. See their case number 10-809 for additional information. Haz-Mat 7 Captain Vasquez, arrived and, after speaking with Sacramento County Haz-Mat, agreed to take command of the incident. He spoke with the property owner and it was agreed that fire department crews on scene would pick up the contaminated dirt, bag it, and the towing company, 5 Star Towing, would dispose of the material.

Medic 71 was assigned to patient care. The injured homeowner denied transportation to the hospital so Medic 71 started to force entry through the front garage door using a circular saw. Engine 71 initiated fire attack from the C side of the structure through the exterior door into the garage. Truck 74 arrived on scene and ladder the structure in preparation for vertical ventilation. Engine 74 arrived on scene and pulled a second hoseline through the A side front door to check for extension into the structure and assisted with water supply to Engine 71. Engine 71 had knockdown on the fire. Truck 7 checked the attic for possible extension and nothing was found. Truck 74 exited the roof and did not vertically ventilate. Truck 74 met up with Fire Attack and assisted with overhaul and extinguishment. Engine 76 arrived on scene and was assigned RIC. Medic 71 was contacted by the injured homeowner and wished to be transported to Methodist Hospital Sacramento. Overhaul was completed and a board-up crew was requested. Contact was made with the homeowner, Joey Rangel, regarding removal of personal items from the residence. Upon entry with the homeowner, the two firefighters from Engine 71 noticed that two of the smoke detectors inside the structure were tampered with and inoperable. The homeowner was counseled on the importance of working and correctly installed smoke detectors. The board up crew arrived and closed up the structure. All units cleared and returned to quarters.
