Official Rules for Giant Pumpkin and Produce Competition

1) The entry must be grown, cared for, from seed to harvest, and exhibited by the grower. In case of an emergency, the site coordinator, club/grower representative, and site representative will make a decision on the validity of the excuse. Only the heaviest entry, one per class (pumpkin-squash) from one fixed address/household will be eligible for GPC prize money.

2) The GPC will recognize two entries per fixed address/household for top ten average only.

3) No foreign material (i.e. fungicides, caulking, skin additives, etc.) will be permitted in the weighing of any fruit. Vines must be trimmed to within one inch of the stem of the fruit. The judges have the right to inspect any and all fruit before weights and measurements become official. Refusal of any inspection to an entry will cause the entry to be classified exhibition only.

4) The specimen must be sound, healthy, and undamaged. Entries must be free of rot, holes or cracks through to the cavity, and serious soft spots.

- The Judges reserve the right to probe cracks, holes, and dig out soft spots to judge a fruit official or not. Before the Judges can execute any of the previous they must have the grower present.

- A serious soft spot is one that is greater than 3 inches in diameter, and greater than 3 inches deep. The dimensions of the soft spot will be measured after all soft material has been removed with a spoon.

- If there are more than two soft spots that require material to be removed and measured, the pumpkin will be disqualified even if each spot is smaller than the definition of a "serious soft spot".

- All judging will be completed prior to the fruit being officially weighed.

5) No specimen will be allowed into competition at a GPC site if that specimen has been previously entered at another competition.

6) All specimens that will be submitted to the GPC for prize money and recognition must be weighed on a certified scale with only the fruit on the scale. Any fruit weighed with a tarp, pallet, or any other lifting device will be classified unofficial weight or UOW.

Color Requirements and Prize Money

1) The CSD limits one prize per category per household.

2) Heaviest official fruit wins—all pumpkins and squash will be weighed in one category with the heaviest fruit winning.

- Squash will be classified as follows—100% of the following colors or color combinations green, blue, and gray. The surface area of the fruit as grown in the garden, not including the portion that was in contact with, or close proximity to the ground. This area will include the area between the ribs, around the stem, and the blossom end. This will not include any netting (cantaloping) or any discoloration caused by the close proximity to, or the area on the ground.

- Pumpkins will be all fruit not classified as squash.

3) In the event of a tie of two or more places, all entries that are tied will have the prize money for the places that are tied added together then split equally amongst the places that are involved.

4) Cosumnes CSD and the CSD Giant Pumpkin Festival staff are not responsible for any damage to specimens.

5) Decisions of the judges are final in all cases.

The top 3 pumpkin entries are required to remain on site until 5:30 pm SUNDAY, October 2nd.

Pre-registration is encouraged but not required.

All participants who pre-register by September 16th will receive a free parking pass. For participants not possessing a pass, there will be a \$5 per car entry fee.

All specimens must be accompanied by their owners, with a completed entry form if not pre-registered and must arrive at Elk Grove Regional Park between 7:00 am and 9:00 am on Saturday, October 1st. **All entries checked in after 9:00 am will be placed in the Non-Competitive category and ineligible to receive a prize. Large specimens should be brought on pallets.** Festival personnel will be on hand to assist entrants in positioning entries. **All registered pumpkins must remain on display until 5:30 pm Saturday, October 1, 2011. The top 3 pumpkins must remain on display until 5:30 pm Sunday, October 2, 2011. All entries are encouraged to remain on display through Sunday.**

Local awards will be presented at approximately 4:00 pm on Saturday, October 1, 2011.

Judging
