

**SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING #3 REGARDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE DISTRICT'S VOTING DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA VOTING RIGHTS ACT**

## **RECOMMENDATION**

The Board of Directors:

1. Reviews the staff report and a presentation on the 3 draft maps by Demographer Redistricting Partners
2. Opens the public hearing and accepts input on the draft maps, composition of the voting districts, and sequence of the voting districts up for election in 2020
3. Closes the public hearing
4. Provides direction to staff on additional information needed for the next public hearing and any changes to the draft voting maps

No formal action is required. The next public hearing is set for August 21, 2019.

## **BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS**

Elections Code Section 10010(a) requires the District to hold 5 public hearings prior to adoption of a resolution converting from at-large to by-district elections. The District held the first 2 public hearings on June 5th and June 19th to allow for the public and the Board to provide input regarding the composition of the District's voting districts. Based on the comments provided during those hearings, the District's demographer, Redistricting Partners, prepared 3 draft voting maps.

The District is now required to hold 2 additional public hearings within a 45 day period to consider public input on the draft voting maps and sequence of election for the voting districts within those maps. In accordance with state law, the 3 draft maps and the Board's designation that the odd-numbered districts in each voting map be up for election in 2020 was published on the District's website on July 12, 2019. While no noticing provisions are required, the District sent notice of the August public hearings to the Galt City Clerk and Elk Grove City Clerk. Notice of the public hearings was also published in the Elk Grove Citizen and Galt Herald.

This is the first of 2 public hearings required to consider the draft maps and sequence of election for the voting districts, and the third public hearing in the process.

Next Steps

The next public hearing is scheduled for the August 21, 2019 meeting. Prior to or at this public hearing, the public is encouraged to provide input via several methods including by email to [clerkoftheboard@yourcsd.com](mailto:clerkoftheboard@yourcsd.com), by dropping off written comments with the Board Clerk at 8820 Elk Grove Blvd, Elk Grove, CA 95624, or by attending a public hearing and providing oral or written comments.

A final public hearing will be held for the adoption of a resolution establishing district-based elections and approving the final voting districts' map. The Board is the final decision-making body on adopting the voting district boundaries.

**FINANCIAL ANALYSIS**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this public hearing.






