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***Fee for Responding to an Excessive Number of False or Malfunctioning Alarms at a Given Location**

The fee shall be paid by the party giving the false or malfunctioning alarm or the property owner whose alarm system gives the false alarm. A false alarm is giving, signaling, or transmission to the Cosumnes CSD Fire Department, the Sacramento Regional Fire/EMS Communications Center, or to any officer or employee thereof, whether by telephone, spoken word, or otherwise, information that there is a fire or emergency at or near the place indicated by the person giving, signaling, or transmitting such information and there is found to be no need for Fire Department services. A written notice of the Fire Department's response to the false or malfunctioning alarm will be provided to the owner/occupant of the building at the time of the response. If the building is unoccupied, the notice will be posted in a conspicuous location. A fee is due when:

The third false or malfunctioning alarm is received from the same location within any 12-month period; or the false alarm is generated by a fire sprinkler/alarm contractor.

****Fee for Providing Hazardous Material Response within the District**

The fee shall be paid by the party generating the hazardous materials. A fee is due when:

The Cosumnes CSD Fire Department responds to a Level I and Level II hazardous material incident that requires the presence of firefighters and equipment for at least one hour or longer or that requires exclusionary zone entry.
